I-485

We submitted a follow-up inquiry to USCIS regarding the status of your I-485 application on July 6, 2026. On July 9, 2026, we submitted the change of address online. We will let you know if there are any issues, as until they accept and process the G-28, we may not be recognized as your authorized representative.

As of today July 24, 2026, we have not received any updates from the USCIS. We will continue to monitor your case and will notify you as soon as we hear back from USCIS.

EAD / SSN

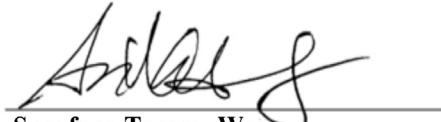
For your EAD (I-765) application, the last update online just says it is still being processed as of November 17, 2025. We can try to follow up with the relevant agency, but they usually do not respond at all until 10 months have elapsed from the date of filing.

As you mentioned, official filing date listed on the I-797 form is October 24, 2025, as such we will follow up with EAD/SSN status in due course.
